The methodology, including the use of validated instruments and statistical analysis (Pearson correlation and t-tests), is sound. However, the article could benefit from a deeper analysis of the causal mechanisms behind the relationship between attitude and achievement, including potential moderating variables like teaching style or classroom environment.

However, some of the sources are somewhat dated, and the inclusion of more recent studies or research on indigenous languages, oral literature, and education in Africa could enhance the manuscript. The language is generally clear but occasionally lacks the polish expected for scholarly communications. Some sentences are awkward or redundant, and a more concise and formal tone would improve readability. Additionally, the grammar and structure could be refined, particularly in the introduction and conclusion, to ensure clarity and coherence.	
Optional/General comments	The study offers a valuable contribution to the field of educational research, particularly in the context of indigenous African languages and oral literature. The manuscript could be strengthened by providing more context on how cultural relevance in teaching methods can be better implemented and by offering a more in-depth analysis of the practical implications of the findings. The overall structure is appropriate, but some minor revisions in language and clarity would improve the manuscript's overall quality.
